II. Transportation (from Siem Reap international airport to Angkor Paradise)

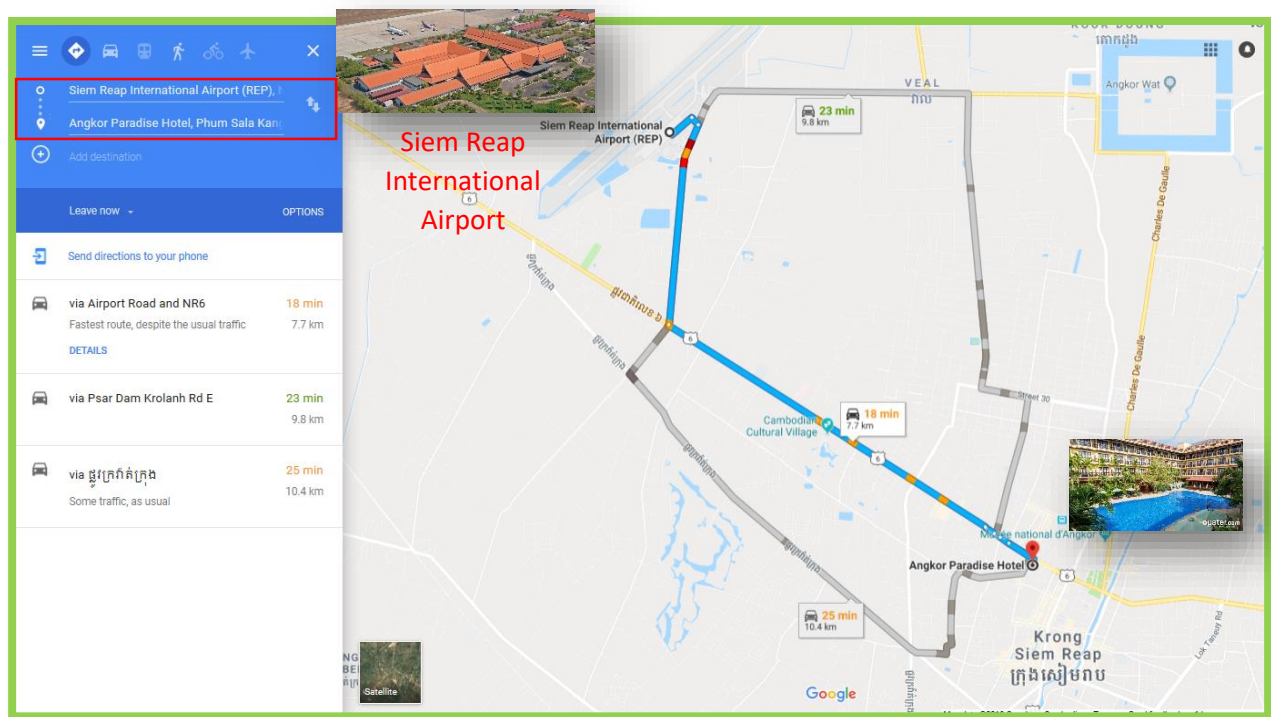
Please note that there is no staff at airport so refer to taxi information for pick up.

- **Hotel Taxi Service**

If you want to hotel staff pick up, please contact to hotel for arrangement (Tel: . The price is the same rate at the airport taxi (10\$ per way) Email to contact: +855 63 760 690; Email: rsvn@angkorparadis.net.

- **Airport Taxi Service**

Please take Taxi; The price for a taxi ride is usually a flat rate, between 40,000 Riel and 60,000 Riel, around 10-15 US Dollars. One of the important ways to stay safe when taking taxis in Siem Reap is by asking all the important questions before you get in the taxi, and all the drivers can speak English.



- **Visa information**

Participants are responsible for obtaining their own entry and/or transit visa(s) to Cambodia, if required. All participants must travel with passport with a minimum validity of 6 months, counted from the date of entry into the country. In Case your country doesn't have Cambodia Embassy, you can apply Visa on the arrival.

- **Accommodation and Hotel Information**

All participant will be made booking at the Hotel by UNITAR, which includes a standard room with breakfast from 24 to 28 of March 2019, depending on the participant's arrival and departure ticket. For UNEP/UNITAR has been paid directly for all participants.

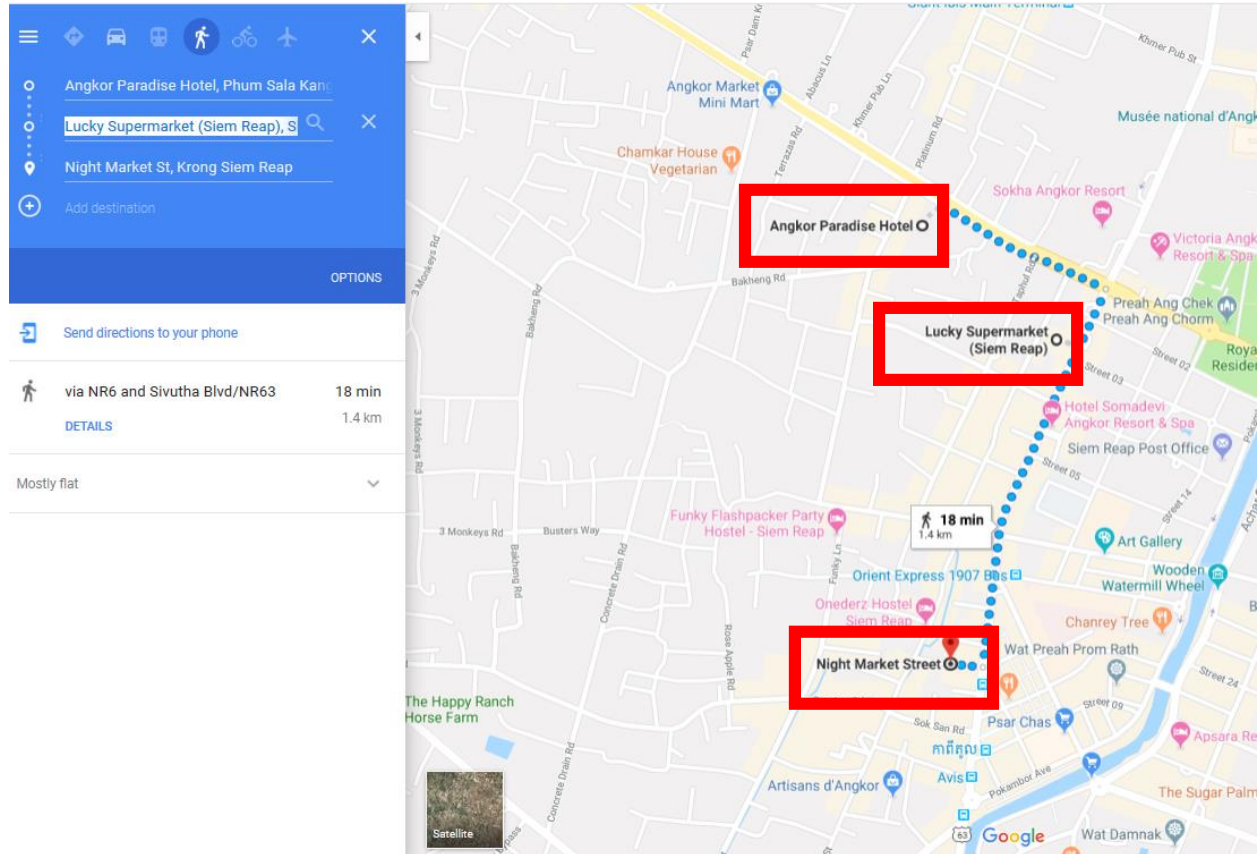

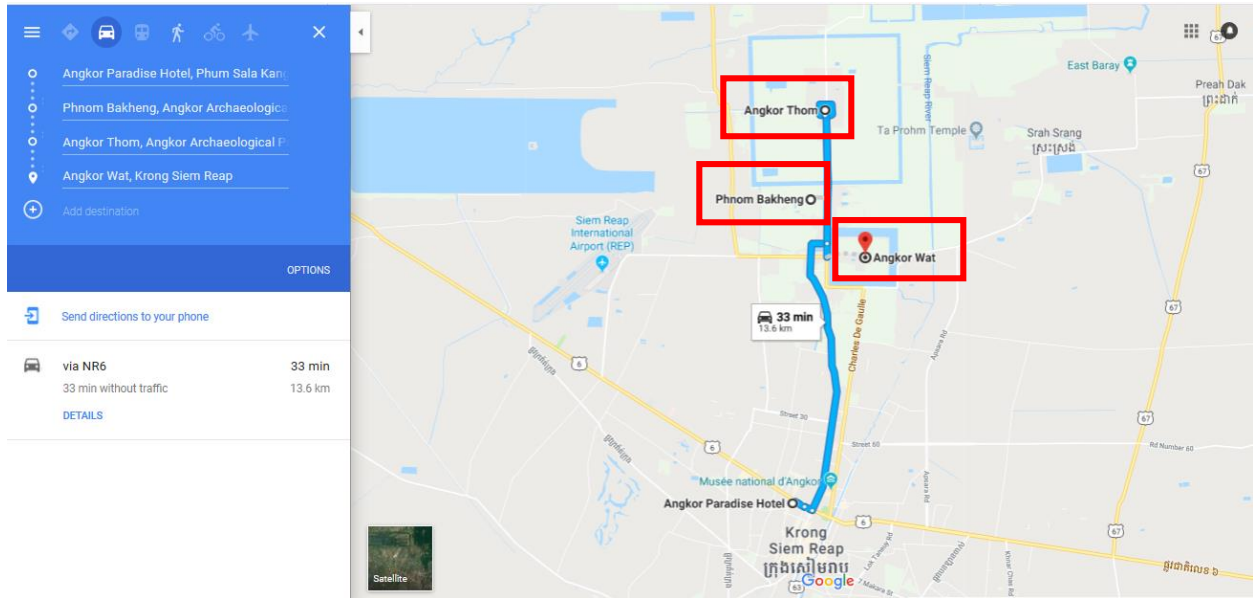

1. Angkor Wat Temple

Angkor Wat, in its beauty and state of preservation, is unrivaled. Its mightiness and magnificence bespeak a pomp and a luxury surpassing that of a Pharaoh or a Shah Jahan, an impressiveness greater than that of the Pyramids, an artistic distinctiveness as fine as that of the Taj Mahal. Angkor Wat is located about six kilometers (four miles) north of Siem Reap, south of **Angkor Thom**. Entry and exit to Angkor Wat can only be access from its west gate.



1. Angkor Thom Temple

Angkor Thom is an almost square city surrounded by 8-meter-high walls a little over 12 kilometers long with five impressive gopura gates providing access to the city. The city's name translates to "large city" or "great city".



2. Phnom Bakheng (Bakheng Mountain)

Phnom Bakheng is located 1,30 meters (4,265 feet) north of Angkor Wat and 400 meters (1,312 feet) south of Angkor Thom. It was nice view in the sunset.¹

- **Weather**

Cambodia has 2 seasons, they are rainy season and dry season, on 24-28 March is dry season, it is a good time to visit Siem Reap Angkor. The average weather conditions in Siem Reap in March are 25°C-34°C.

- **Official Language**

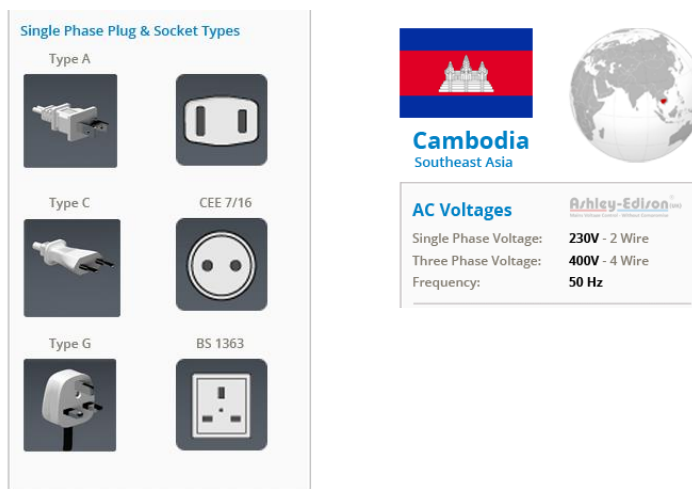
The main spoken language is Khmer, and official used is English.

- **Currency**

Cambodia's official monetary unit is the Riel which it consists of a one hundred until fifty thousand riel or One hundred thousand riel; US Dollars will also be accepted. The rate is 1 US dollar is roughly equivalent to 4,050 Riel.

- **Electricity and Voltage**

The standard voltage in Cambodia is 220 volts
