- Changes of staff within the Ministry and in PRTR teams and project coordination
- Language barriers (translation of documents/reports/guidance materials)
- Improved coordination at national level → Interministerial coordination mechanism is key
- Integration of existing reporting platform in a single window reporting
- Lack of political willingness and/or commitment to adopt national PRTR legislation → PRTRs in the national agenda!
- Administrative burdens of public authorities can cause delays in project implementation
